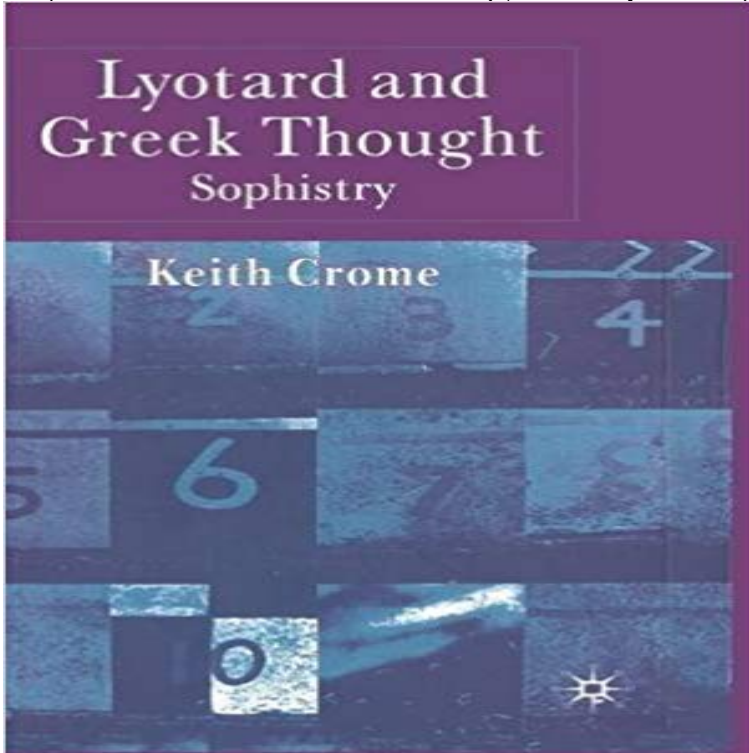


Lyotard and Greek Thought: Sophistry
