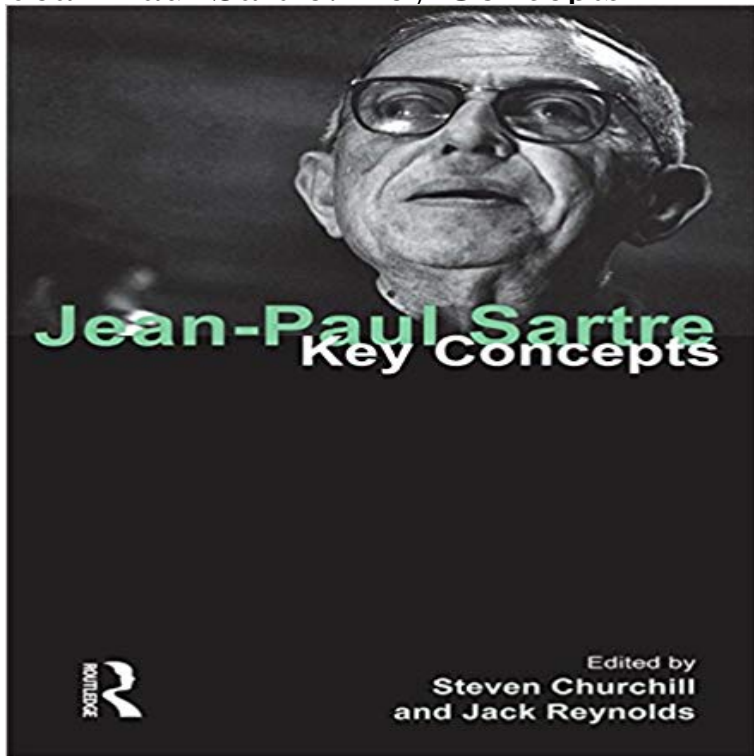


## Jean-Paul Sartre: Key Concepts
