

Karl Popper, creator of Fallibilism (or Critical Rationalism), is often considered one of the great philosophers, ranking alongside Plato, Hume, Kant, and Russell. He developed a worldwide following during his lifetime; was knighted, and received numerous other accolades and rare prizes. However, close examination of his work reveals so many flaws and self-contradictions that any objective analyst is bound to wonder whether his reputation was deserved. Some of his admirers have compared his work to that of Ayn Rand and suggested that Poppers work could serve as the basis for a Libertarian political philosophy. These essays show that this point of view is mistaken.
