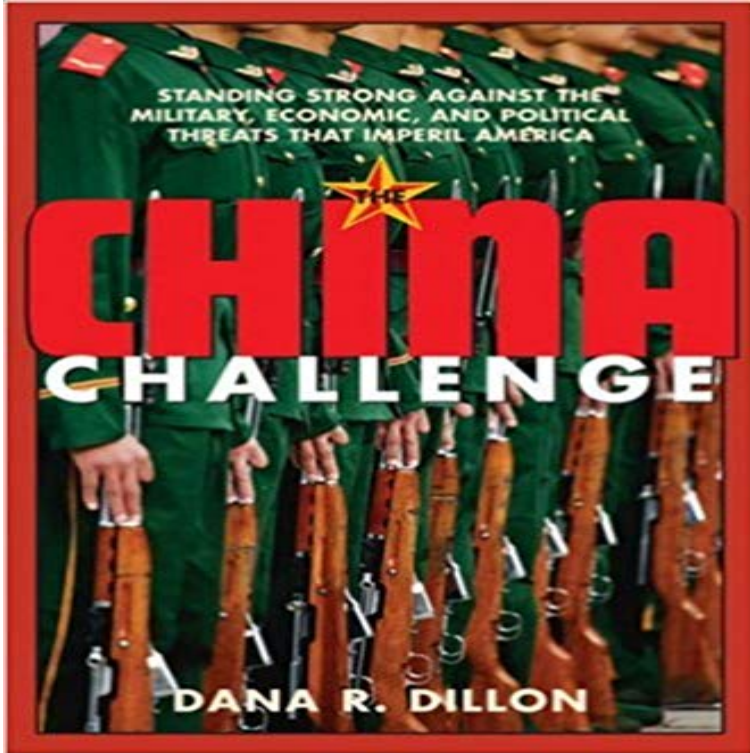


The China Challenge: Standing Strong Against the Military, Economic and Political Threats that Imperil America
