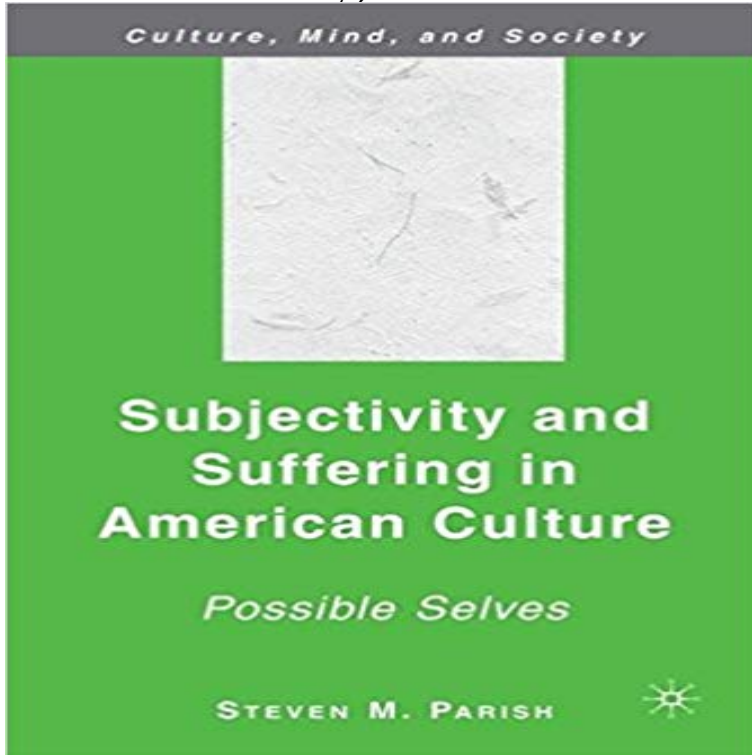


## Subjectivity and Suffering in American Culture: Possible Selves (Culture, Mind and Society)
