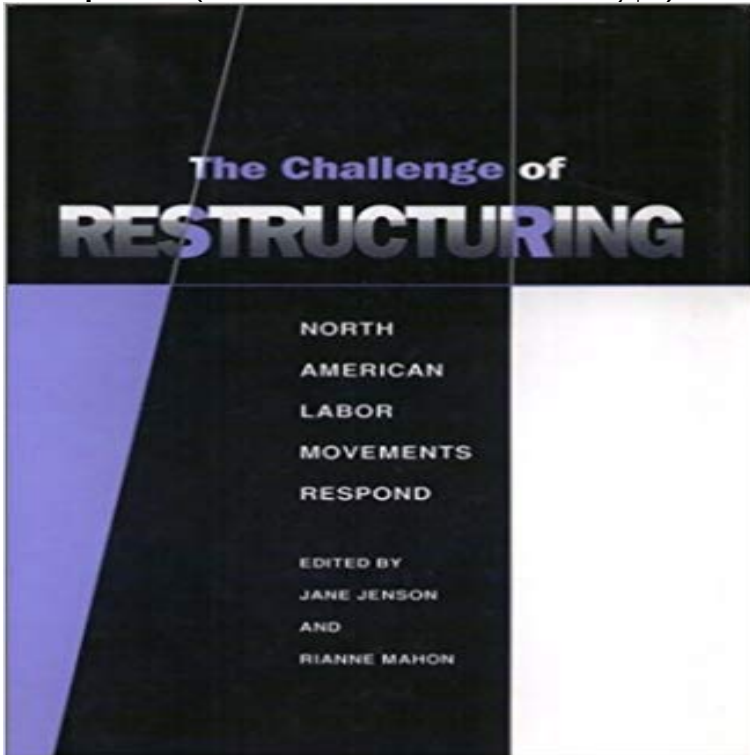


# The Challenge of Restructuring: North American Labor Movements Respond (Labor & Social Change)
