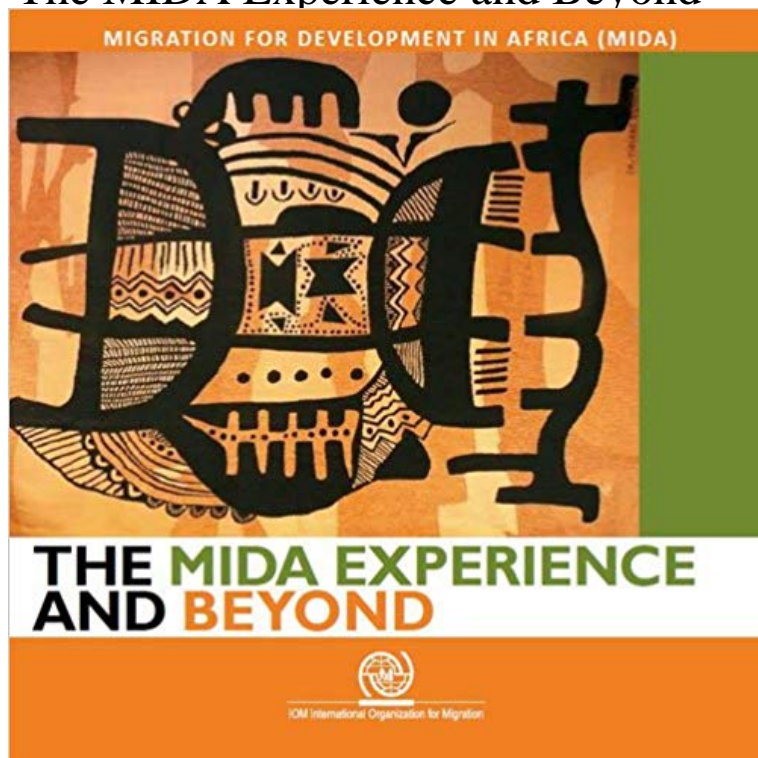


The MIDA Experience and Beyond
