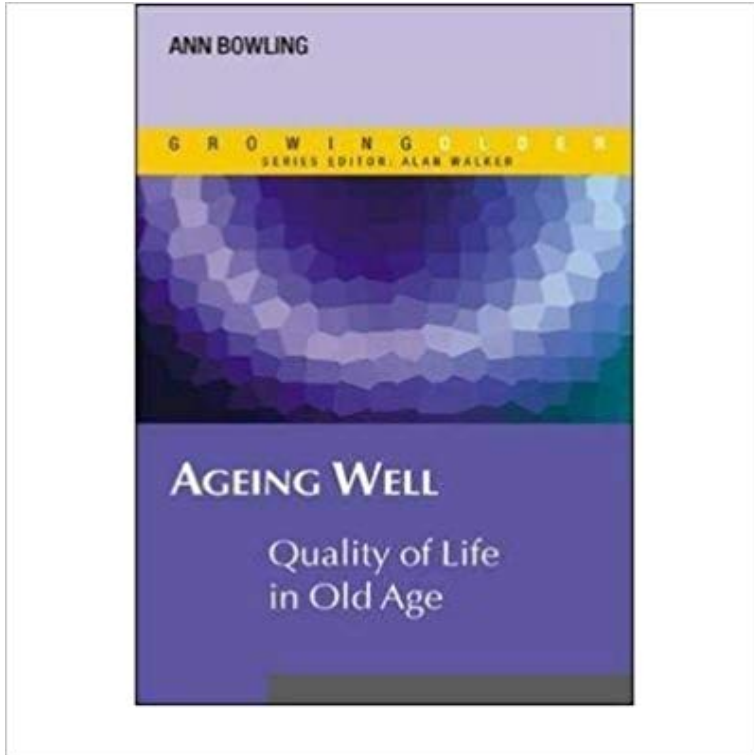


Ageing Well: Quality of Life in Old Age (Growing Older) (Paperback) - Common
