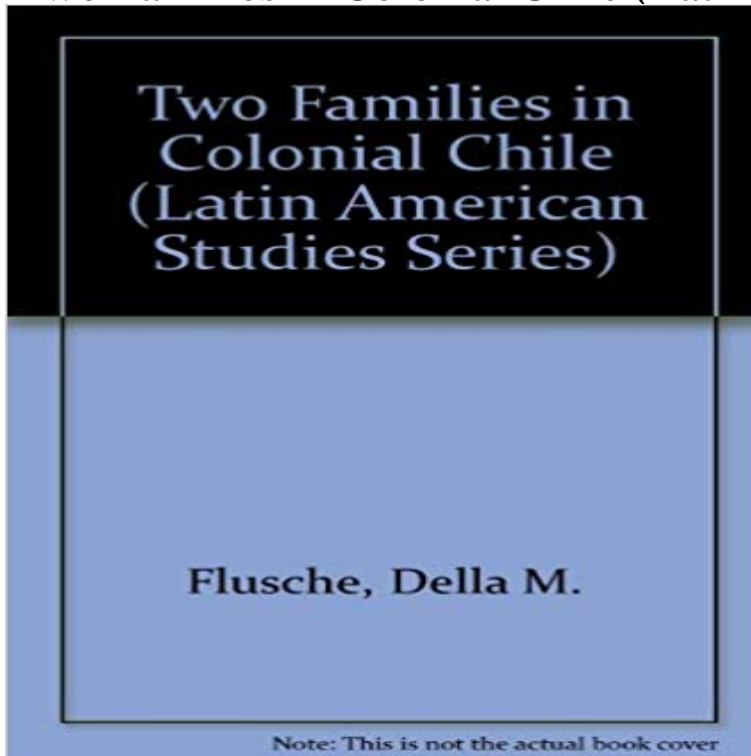


Two Families in Colonial Chile (Latin American Studies)
