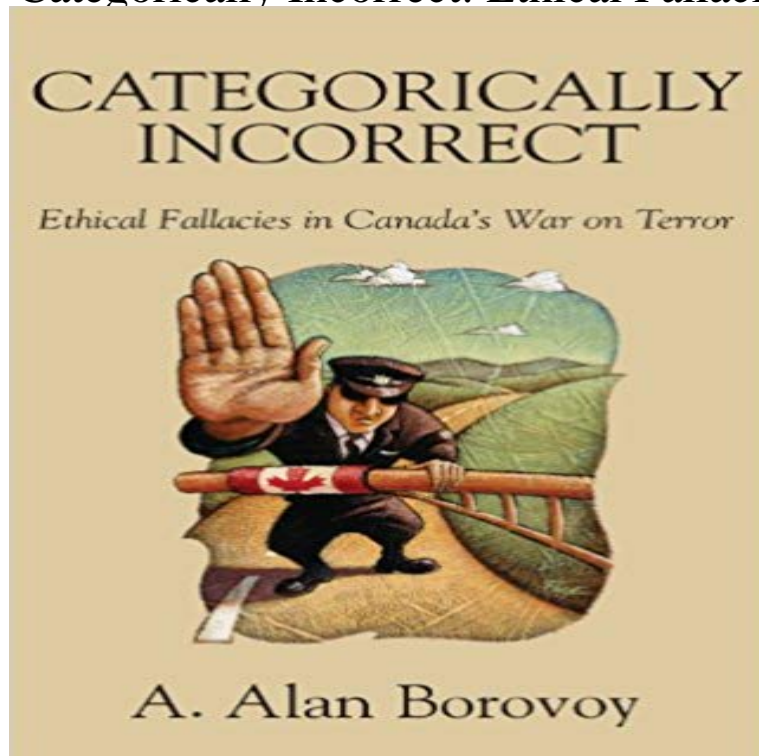


Categorically Incorrect: Ethical Fallacies in Canadas War on Terror
